
STATE OF HAWAII DEPARTMENT OF BUDGET AND FINANCE ORGANIZATION CHART



DEPARTMENT OF BUDGET AND FINANCE MAJOR FUNCTIONS

- Administers the multi-year program and financial plan and executive budget, management improvement, and financial management programs of the state under the general direction of the Governor.
- Coordinates state budget services and prepares the Governor's budget for submission to the legislature; administers the financial affairs of the State.
- Plans, directs and coordinates the State's investments and financing programs.

- Directs and coordinates a statewide retirement benefits program for state and county government employees.
- Administers health and life insurance benefits for eligible state and county active and retired public employees and dependents.
- Provides comprehensive legal and related services to persons who are financially unable to obtain legal and related services.
- Regulates all chartered, franchised, or certificated public service companies operating in the State.
