#### Major Budget Adjustments (New Admin): (general funds unless noted)

- 1. Restored 2.00 permanent position counts for the Deputy Adjutant General and the Private Secretary.
- 2. Added \$5,440,261 in FY 12 and \$1,046,096 in FY 13 for maintenance of veteran cemeteries, statewide (100% federal reimbursement).
- 3. Added \$60,000 and \$3,288,681 in federal funds in FY 12 and FY 13, and 4.00 temporary federal fund positions to operate the Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention program.
- 4. Convert 4.80 permanent federal fund positions to general funds to allow for maintenance of Department of Defense facilities.
- 5. Added \$312,880 in FY 12 and \$328,168 in FY 13 to provide Tuition Assistance funds for Hawaii National Guard qualified members.
- 6. Added 13.00 permanent federal fund positions in FY 12 and FY 13, and federal funds of \$622,650 in FY 12 and \$830,600 in FY 13 for the operations of Hawaii Army National Guard Facilities Readiness Centers.
- 7. Added 1.00 temporary federal fund position in FY 12 and FY 13, and federal funds of \$1,395,245 in FY 12 and \$1,385,245 in FY 13 to establish a pilot Joint Forces Head Quarters Communication system for connectivity between the State Civil Defense, Hawaii National Guard and the continental United States.
- 8. Converted 7.65 temporary positions from general funds to federal funds for the Hawaii National Guard, Youth Challenge Academy. The matching state/federal requirements have been changed from 40% state / 60% federal to 25% state / 75% federal.

### Highlights of the CIP Budget Adjustments (New Admin): (general obligation bonds unless noted)

- 1. Added \$1,650,000 and \$39,481,000 in federal funds for FY 12 and \$50,000 and \$695,000 in federal funds for FY 13 to renovate Building 117 at Kalaeloa for the Hawaii National Guard.
- 2. Added \$450,000 for FY 12 and \$450,000 and \$33,000,000 in federal funds for FY 13 for the 29th Infantry Brigade Combat Team Readiness Center in Kalaeloa.
- 3. Added \$1,800,000 and \$1,000,000 in federal funds in FY 12 and \$500,000 and \$16,500,000 in federal funds in FY 13 for minor military construction and renovation to Army Guard facilities on Oahu.
- 4. Added \$1,400,000 and \$3,200,000 in federal funds for FY 12 and \$700,000 and \$840,000 in federal funds for FY 13 for upgrades and improvements to National Guard armories.
- 5. Added \$2,660,000 and \$2,000 in federal funds for FY 12 and \$3,034,000 and \$1,000 in federal funds for FY 13 for cemetery improvements and additional columbaria niches at various veteran cemeteries throughout the State.
