SUBJECT: Community-based work-furlough program for eligible women inmates in the

custody of the Department of Public Safety

Purpose:

The Department has had success with community-based work-furlough residential programs in preparing eligible women inmates for release and re-entry into the community. The purpose of this directive is to ensure that such community-based programs continue. This directive ensures that eligible women inmates will have at least one option for community-based rehabilitative services and assistance in transitioning from imprisonment back to society.

Directive:

During the 2020-2021 fiscal year, the Department shall procure, pursuant to Hawai'i Revised Statutes Chapter 103D, and administer at least one community-based, residential work-furlough program for women inmates in the custody of the Department.

This Directive shall be effective from the date of this directive until it is terminated by separate directive.
