SECTION I: ALLOCATED COSTS

The central service costs listed in Exhibit A, attached, are approved on a <u>fixed</u> basis and may be included as part of The State/local departments and agencies indicated during your fiscal year ended June 30, 2021, for further allocation to Federal grants, contracts and other agreements performed at those departments and agencies.

SECTION II: BILLED COSTS

In addition to Section I, which provides for services furnished but not billed, the services listed below are furnished and billed to State/local departments and agencies.

SECTION III: SPECIAL REMARKS

Cost Allocation Plan

Charges for Fringe Benefits cited in Section II are billed only to special (restricted) fund activities including Federal projects. Department/agency indirect cost rate proposals will include any adjustments necessary to segregate these costs in Section I between the following categories: (1) those which are identifiable to direct programs funded from State general funds, and (2) those which are identifiable with administrative functions of the department/agency.

Costs identified with category (1) will be included in the direct cost base, and costs identified with category (2) will be considered to be indirect costs.

Data Processing charges will be billed in accordance with rates established by the State and included in the records of the Information and Communications Services Division (ICSD). The variances between billed costs and actual costs must be carried forward in the computation of future billing rates; but no later than the second succeeding year. It is the responsibility of ICSD to notify departments of billing amounts for each department.

Fringe Benefits

Charges for fringe benefits cited in Section II include pension accumulation, pension administration, other post-retirement benefits, social security taxes, Medicare, health, dental, and life insurance, unemployment compensation, and workers compensation.

For charging purposes, the following benefits rates may be used: Fixed for the Period 7/1/20 - 6/30/21

Pension Accumulation	23.78%
Pension Administration	0.01%
Other Post-Retirement Benefits	12.50%
Retiree Health Insurance	11.22%
Workers' Compensation	1.63%
Unemployment Compensation	0.03%

All other benefits will be charged based on the actual rates in effect at the time the charges are made.

SECTION IV: CONDITIONS

The amounts approved in Section I and the billings for the services listed in Section II are subject to the following conditions:

A.LIM<u>ITATIONS: (1)</u> Charges resulting from this Agreement are subject to any statutory or administrative limitations and apply to a given grant, contract or other agreement only to the extent that funds are available. (2) Such charges represent costs incurred by the State/locality which are legal obligations of the State/locality and are allowable under Title 2 of the Code of Federal Regulations, Part 200 (2 CFR 200). (3) The same costs that are treated as indirect costs are not claimed as direct costs. (4) Similar types of costs are accorded consistent accounting treatment. (5) The information provided by the State/locality which was used to establish this

Agreement is not later found to be materially incomplete or inaccurate.

B.ACC<u>OUNTING CHANGES: This Agreement is based on the accounting system purported by the State/locality to be in effect during the Agreement period. Changes to the method of accounting for costs which affect the amount of reimbursement resulting from use of this Agreement require prior approval of the authorized representative of the Cognizant Agency. Such changes include, but are not limited to, changes in the charging of a particular type of cost from allocated cost to a billed cost. Failure to obtain approval may result in cost disallowances.</u>

- C. FIXED AMOUNTS: If fixed amounts are approved in Section I of this Agreement, they are based on an estimate of the costs for the period covered by the Agreement. When the actual costs for this period are determined, adjustments will be made to the amounts of a future year to compensate for the difference between the costs used to establish the fixed amounts and actual costs.
- D.BILLED COSTS: Charges for the services listed in Section II will be billed in accordance with rates established by the State/locality. These rates will be based on the estimated costs of providing the services. Adjustments for variances between billed costs and the actual allowable costs of providing the services, as defined by 2 CFR 200, will be made in accordance with procedures agreed to between the State/locality and the Cognizant Agency.
- E. USE <u>BY OTHER FEDERAL AGENCIES</u>: <u>This</u> Agreement was executed in accordance with the authority in 2 CFR 200, and should be applied to grants, contracts and other agreements covered by 2 CFR 200, subject to any limitations in Paragraph A above. The State/locality may provide copies of the Agreement to other Federal Agencies to give them early notification of the Agreement.
